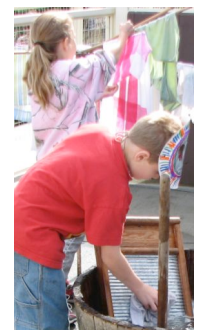

Logs were sawed, fields were plowed, and corn was ground away!



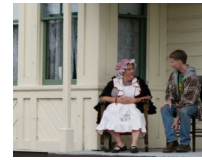
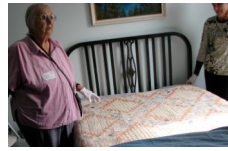
The music was great, stories were told, people picnicked in the sun.

Quilts were turned, bird masks were made, and wool was carded and spun.



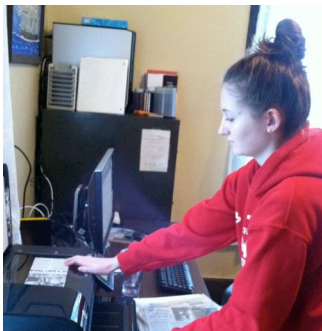
Thank you for coming, we're glad you did, we look forward to next year. That's when we'll get our chance again to be a Pioneer!



## Volunteer Spotlight

The Duvall Historical Society consists of members and volunteers who help preserve, record, publish, and promote the appreciation of, the history of our region. Working on a project led by Kimberly Engelkes, one volunteer gave a lot of her own time to help us in our mission.

In 2011 we received a Heritage Collections Care grant from 4Culture, the King County Cultural Services Agency. With it, we began the second phase of our digital archiving plan to preserve and archive the ephemera and historic documents in our collection.
